

The Politician's Pledge

"I will stand against any existing or proposed action or law initiated inside or outside Has Not Canada that will compromise the inherent Agreedsovereign rights and freedoms of Canadians. My actions will be based on knowledge, integrity, transparency and accountability." **Transparency** (Returned Questionnaires) A measure of a candidates willingness to respond to No Reply a questionnaire that informs constituents regarding their position on important issues facing constituents. A failure to reply indicates resistance to transparency. -15 %

Public Advocacy in defense of our Rights and Freedoms

Verifiable Positions taken by our representatives in the news, social media, press releases, etc. This is a cumulative measure of the verifiable public records and statements made that address critical issues.
