

The Politician's Pledge "I will stand against any existing or proposed action or law initiated inside or outside Agreed-Canada that will compromise the inherent Agreed sovereign rights and freedoms of Canadians. My actions will be based on knowledge, 20 % integrity, transparency and accountability." **Transparency** (Returned Questionnaires) A measure of a candidates willingness to respond to No Reply a questionnaire that informs constituents regarding their position on important issues facing constituents. A failure to reply indicates resistance to transparency. -15 % Public Advocacy in defense of our Rights and Freedoms Verifiable Positions taken by our representatives in the news, social media, press releases, etc. This is a cumulative measure of the verifiable public records 5 % and statements made that address critical issues.
